This annual report contains the details of various academic and administrative activities carried out by the college in the year 2020-2021. These activities include classes, examinations, seminars, lectures, NCC activities, NSS activities, IQAC activities, sports, cultural activities etc. A brief sketch of such activities along with some other valuable information carried out during this year has been presented below.

Teaching- Learning and Evaluations

In this year, Semester-II of CBCS and UG (1+1+1) system was running simultaneously like the second half of the previous year. Every department conducted the class tests for different papers for honours course (B.A./ B.Sc.) students and a test examination was conducted for general course students for the session 2019-2020. The test examination for the said courses was held on the 2nd week of the January, 2020. The results of this examination were prepared by a tabulation sub-committee and published to the eligible students for appearing in the university examination. The eligible students filled up the university examination form for the final exam. The B.A./B.Sc. (1+1+1) part-I & II examination by University of North Bengal was started on 23rd November to 8th December 2020 (On online and offline mode). The 2nd and 4th semester examination of North Bengal University were held from 14th December, 2020.

The classes of the 3rd & 5th semester Core Course (on online mode) were started on and from 8th August, 2020. The classes of the CBCS Semester- I (CC) was started (on online mode) on and from 1st December 2020. The 1st, 3rd & 5th semester Programme course (on online mode) were started on and from 2nd January, 2021. The evaluation process was divided in two parts namely, internal assessment and university examination. For Core Course students, the internal evaluation was done through class

tests by the departments. For the programme course students internal assessment was done in various ways namely, assignments, project, seminar, class test etc.

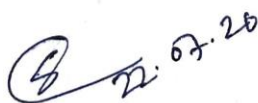

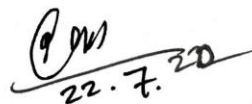
The following resolutions were adopted:

1. COVID-19 pandemic has shifted the dynamics of traditional education process, and it is decided that our college shall shift the teaching-learning process from classroom to online teaching. At the very early stage of pandemic the college was trying to be engaged with students with various online teaching platforms like, Zoom Meeting, TeamLink, WhatsApp, Google Meet etc. IQAC has proposed that every department should create course wise Google Classroom for online teaching. Further, IQAC has decided that Google Meet shall be the regular online class taking platform and WhatsApp shall be used for daily communications.
2. The shift to the online platform opens the doorway to organize seminars and other programme with large scales audiences. IQAC has decided to organize webinars in collaboration with various departments of the college. Google Meet shall be used as recommended platform with YouTube Live telecast.
3. As the regular communication is hampered due to pandemic, IQAC proposes to meet with everyone in a virtual platform once in a month to discuss the status, drawbacks, and further development of teaching learning process.
4. IQAC has proposed that every department shall prepare topic wise study materials for the betterment of the students. The study materials shall be uploaded in the college website with the help of technical sub-committee of the college so that the students at large numbers can access necessary guide during pandemic. The college library also may prepare online open education materials to help for the same cause.

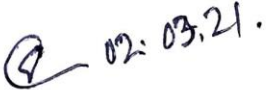

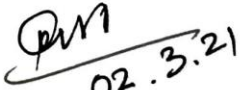
