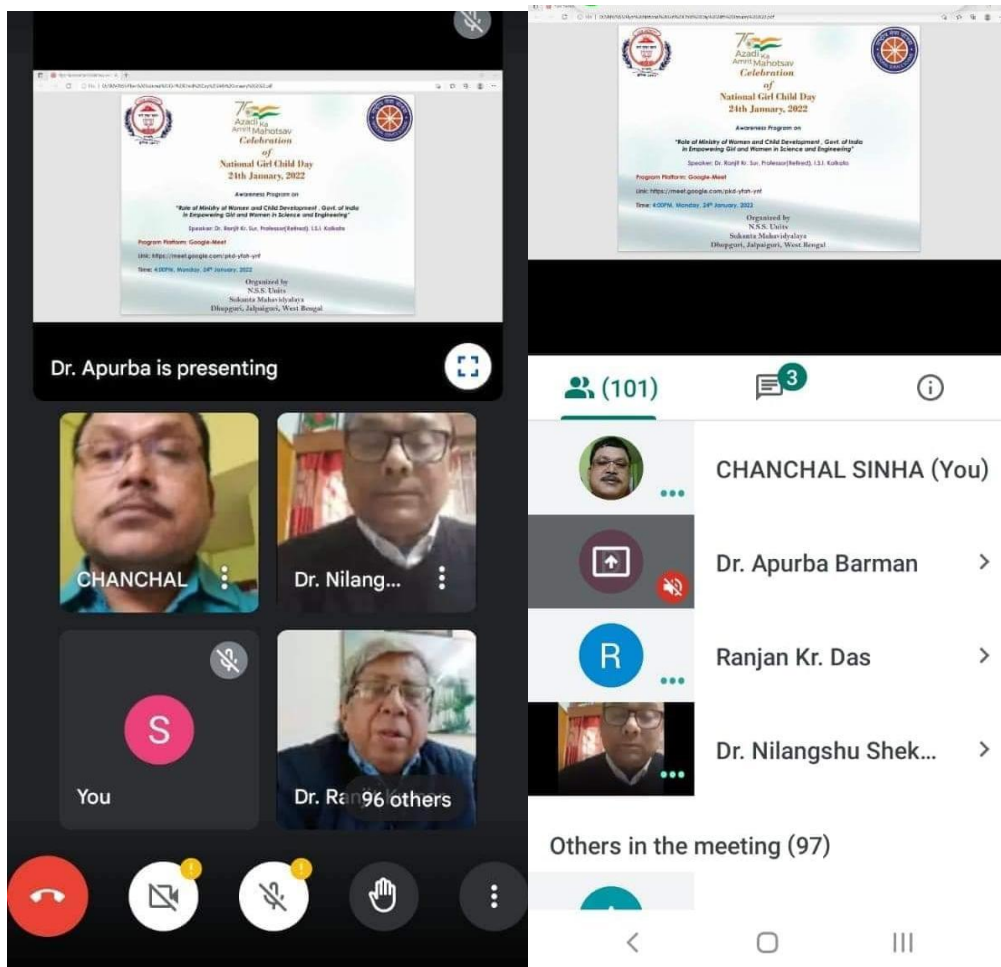


National Girl Child Day:

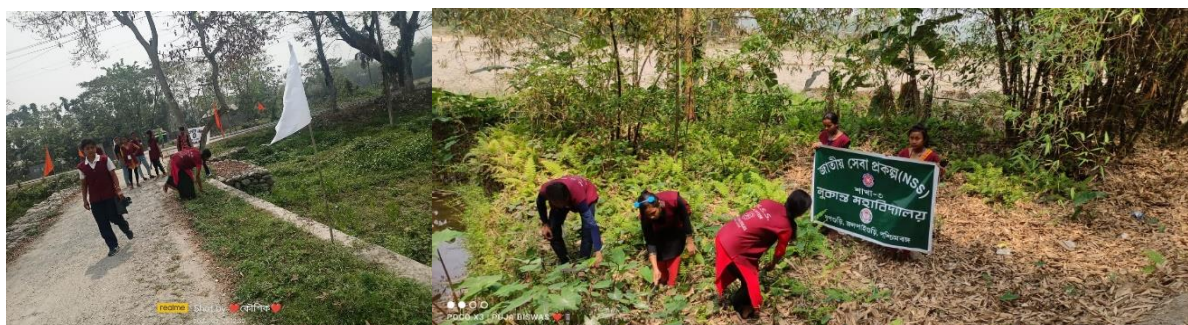
Day-3:24.03.2022
