Short Report of the Activity: A National Level Seminar for the students of the Department of English was organized by Dr Saptarshi Mallick, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Sukanta Mahavidyalaya and Dr Md Masihur Rahman, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Sukanta Mahavidyalaya on 17th January, 2020 on the topic: Literary Texts: Re-Reading Issues and Exploring Interpretations. Dr Sourav Dasthakur, Associate professor, Department of English, Viswa Bharati, Santiniketan, and Dr Sounak Samajdar, Associate Professor, Department of English, Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University, Coochbehar were invited as a Resource person for the Said Seminar.
