The speaker discussed modernism through the Scottish Renaissance which originated in the Celtic Twilight guided by Patrick Geddes, the author of the article “The Scots Renaissance” published in *Evergreen* in 1895. Nevertheless, the inter-war movement is to be distinguished from the Celtic Twilight and the search for a golden age. Whereas both movements searched for the roots of the national spirit, the Renaissance found in cultural precedents a new way to engage Scottish society with its present and its future. The lecture explored through several texts the spirit of renaissance ushered through Scottish Modernism.
