This annual report contains the details of various academic and administrative activities carried out by the college in the year 2019. These activities include classes, examinations, seminars, lectures, NCC activities, NSS activities, IQAC activities, sports, cultural activities etc. A brief sketch of such activities along with some other valuable information carried out during this year have been presented below.

### **Teaching- Learning and Evaluations**

In this year, Semester-II of CBCS and UG (1+1+1) system was running simultaneously like the second half of the previous year. Every department conducted the class tests for different papers for honours course (B.A./ B.Sc.) students and a test examination was conducted for general course students for the session 2018-2019. The results of this examination were prepared by a tabulation sub-committee and published to the eligible students for appearing in the university examination. The eligible students filled up the university examination form for the final exam. The B.A./B.Sc. (1+1+1) part-III examination by University of North Bengal was started on 3rd June, 2019 and continued till 30th June 2019. The B.A./B.Sc. (1+1+1) part-I and part-II examination by University of North Bengal were started on 16th August, 2019.

The classes of the CBCS (semester-II) were started on 2nd January 2019. In this system the teaching-learning process consists of Lecture-Tutorial-Practical (L-T-P) mode. The evaluation process is divided in two parts namely, internal assessment and end semester university examination. For honours course students the internal evaluation was done through class tests by the department. For the programme course students internal assessment was done in various ways namely, assignments, project, seminar, class test etc. The end semester examination was started on 3rd June 2019.
